Acrylics vs Gels, and the Dangers of Budget Nail Bars

Over the past few years, the nail industry has continued to grow and grow. British women are said to spend £450 a year on their nails, and for the first time ever, nail polishes are outselling lipsticks. It's a trend that many celebrities are jumping on with the likes of Kate Moss and Rita Ora collaborating with high street brands to create signature colours and lines.

In fact, nail bars are one of the few business types to increase in branch numbers throughout the recession as many town and city centres across the country saw salons pop up and fill vacant retail spaces. With such a great boom happening, it is important to be aware of the concerns that derive

from 'budget shops' and some of their practices.

A main worry that has caught the attention of the national media is the use of MMA, which was investigated by BBC Inside Out in January 2015. Methyl Methacrylate, or MMA as it is more commonly known, is a strong chemical glue that is banned in the USA but yet is still legal here in the UK. Typically, it is used to repair bone structures in operations such as knee or hip replacements, but some nail bars are using MMA for acrylic nail extensions and overlays as it is considerably cheaper than the safer option, Ethyl Methacrylate (EMA). This is despite the fact that it can cause permanent

damage to the nails and severe allergic reactions.

The report found that one budget shop, which was visited at random, used MMA even though the nail technician stated that it wasn't in their products, and eight out of nine budget shops that were tested in the area were found to be using the chemical. There are concerns that consumers are being misled, or that inexperienced technicians may not be aware of the products they are using.

When it comes to nail treatments, we find that people have a lot of questions about the materials, process and aftercare, so here is a quick guide on the difference between acrylics and, our preference at Beauty at the Gate, gels.



Acrylic nails are the traditional form of extension, and have been popular since the 1970s. They are suited to women who have their hands in water or cleaning products on a regular basis as they are less porous than other overlay materials. The process involves combining liquid acrylic monomers and an acrylic powder to form the substance, which is then moulded to the shape of the nail. This needs to be done quickly as the acrylic begins to harden almost instantly. When applied correctly and carefully, acrylics are long-lasting and durable, however they are known to damage the nail bed, causing nails to become weak and brittle as they are unable to breathe beneath the extension. Applying acrylics does involve more chemicals and fumes (those odours are strong!), and they can look more artificial than other treatments, which is why alternative forms of extensions are becoming more and more popular, such as gels.



Gels are seen as a safer, more gentle alternative to acrylics, and are suitable for most lifestyles and everyday activities. They are a great solution for those who have weaker, more brittle nails too as the nails are able to breathe beneath the extension, allowing them to grow and become stronger. Once the gel has been applied, the technician has more time to perfect the desired shape as the overlay doesn't cure until the fingertips are placed beneath a dedicated UV lamp. And because gel is applied and sealed in thin layers, the result is a strong but flexible nail. Although gels are not as durable as acrylics, they are loved for their natural look and glossy appearance.

To help keep your natural nails in the best possible condition, it is always best to visit an experienced nail technician to ensure that the preparation, application and removal of the extensions is done correctly.

Jemma, Beauty at the Gate's resident nail technician, said: "If the preparation of the nail is done poorly, then that is what can cause damage. Filing is the most important part as this is where you take the layers of the nail down."

Once the overlays have been applied, Jemma recommends using an oil two to three times a day, to wear gloves when doing any washing, gardening or chores, and that nails should always be removed by a professional technician to prevent any further damage - do not pick those nails, however tempting it may be!

"Really, most nails should be replaced every two to three weeks. Most people go about 10 days, but I've seen people leave it for about six weeks, I don't recommend that!"

THE POWER OF VITAMIN A ON THE SKIN

Apricots are rich in beta-carotene, and other foods such as Butternut Squash, Spinach, Kale, Carrots and Sweet Potatoes are effective sources of the vitamin.

But, Vitamin A can also be incorporated into your skincare routine to be absorbed directly by the skin; this philosophy has formed the basis of



Socialising with friends and family, and spending quality time with my partner. Oh and a glass of fizz! Followed closely by some form of outdoor activity, walking and cycling.


Where is your favourite holiday destination?

LASER HAIR REMOVAL



Since introducing laser hair removal in May 2015 we've had somegreat results and fantastic feedback from clients who areundergoing treatment.

It's become common for our clients to see results after the first few sessions, with less hair growth after just two or three treatments.

We've been getting really positive feedback from clients undergoing the treatment with reports of better than expected results. Our therapist Melissa explains what you can expect from laser hair removal. "The treatment is really quick - quicker than a wax. My clients are seeing a difference even after the first treatment but you need to have between six to eight sessions for it to work properly. Hair growth reduces or tends to become patchy after the first couple of sessions, it's fine to shave between treatments so you don't have to walk round with unwanted hair in-between sessions whilst you're having the course. I've had great feedback from all the ladies I'm treating – it's literally life changing! It can make a huge difference to self-confidence especially for ladies who have facial hair."

The treatment itself can be slightly uncomfortable - Melissa describes it as feeling like being pinged with an elastic band. You may experience some redness in the treated area which will fade within 24 hours and become less with each

treatment. Mineral makeup can be applied to cover any redness.

Laser hair removal works on just about any treatment area of the face and body where hair removal is needed - face, underarms, arms, legs and bikini line. Not every hair or skin type can be treated with the laser - we carry out a 30 minute initial consultation to determine if the treatment will work on your hair/skin type.

A few of our clients who have been having treatments have been kind enough to let us know their thoughts on how their treatments have been going.

Rosie Warne from Grimsby told us "I had previously been having electrolysis which although effective does take a long time in terms of treatments as it only targets single hair follicles. I've had about 5 laser treatments with Sam so far and expect to have another 2 or 3.

The results have been better than I expected and I'm very happy with the treatment. There is a lot less hair growth now. The treatment itself does leave me with a little redness for up to 24 hours. It feels like an elastic band snapping on your skin but it hurts less each time I have it done. I just wish it was a little bit cheaper so I could get more areas treated."





Adele Maroney from New Waltham told us "I've had 3 treatments so far and I couldn't believe that I saw results after the very first treatment. It's slightly uncomfortable but the treatment is so quick and any redness I get subsides after a few hours

It's made me feel a lot more confident and I cant believe how quick the process is and the results I'm seeing after only 3 treatments."

Sue Parkington from Cleethorpes told us "I'm half way through a course of 6 treatments and regrowth has been vastly reduced. The laser produces a slight stinging sensation but only in seconds in each area so I find it bearable.

I'm very happy so far and am looking forward to finishing the course. Melissa is lovely and makes the treatment pleasant and comfortable, I would recommend having laser Hair removal at BATG."
