Every year the Professional Beauty Awards celebrates the best salons that the UK has to offer. Now that the shortlist of finalists has been selected, beauticians across the country are excitedly gearing up for the award ceremony in February. We are very proud and honoured to have been nominated alongside 4 amazing salons. We look at some of the other finalists starting with The Cabin from Ventnor on the Isle of Wight.

The Cabin

Looking out over the stunning coastline of the Isle of Wight, The Cabin has the perfect backdrop for a tranquil pamper session. Based in Ventnor, a town that has long been known as the best place to visit for a spa retreat, The Cabin fits in perfectly, ensuring those searching for a bit of rest and relaxation are well serviced.

Offering massage, facials, wraps, exfoliation treatments and pedicures, all are performed using organic products where possible. Some of the more luxurious treatments can take up to three hours to complete, which means three hours of pure bliss for their clients. Whereas those with less time to spend can choose from one of the mini treatments available.



The ethos of the salon is "Prevent, Maintain, Improve" and it is clear to see that the well-being of the client is their number one priority. The product brand of choice is Voya, a seaweedbased natural and organic range that has won numerous skincare awards.

There are also products to buy, to ensure that clients can continue to enjoy a pamper session between appointments. Treatments such as the Aromatherapy Prescription Facial and the Sports Massage show that The Cabin is much more than just a beauty parlour; it aims to improve its client's overall health through bespoke treatments that will work for them.



The Salon also chooses to help the environment wherever possible, and this is reflected in the sustainable bamboo floors, recycled slate roof, low energy lighting, and bee-friendly terrace.

Run by Rowena Amos, an experienced Reiki and massage therapist, The Cabin first opened for business in 2012. Soon after, the second treatment room was opened and named The Crow's Nest. With a third room in the nearby four-star Royal Hotel, business is booming, and Rowena already has plans for a fourth treatment room aimed at couples, which is set to open next Summer.

The friendly and experienced team consists of Grace Berryman, Erin Saxcoburg, Grace Wedlock-Ward, and Kelsey Balfour, as well as Rowena.

When visiting, you can expect a warm welcome, complete with teas, coffees and healthy snacks. If booked in advance, they will happily serve you wine, prosecco or champagne for the ultimate decadent experience. Despite these welcome extras, Rowena believes that her salon offers treatments that are essential to the well-being of her clients, rather than a luxury they could do without.

When visited by the Pro Beauty mystery shopper and the judge, Rowena was heavily pregnant and is delighted that the extra challenges this brought did not prevent her salon from making a good impression. She said:

"All the team will be attending the awards show at The Brewery, London in February and we are really looking forward to a well-deserved night out. While it would, of course, be the perfect ending to win the award, we are very proud to have made it through this far to the last five."

INDUSTRY PROFILE Karen Betts



Karen Betts is one of the most inspiring women in beauty today; she is the UK's leading permanent make-up artist and trainer as well as running the hugely successful Nouveau **Beauty Group of companies** which includes many of BATG's most popular brand treatments -HD Brows, A-Lift, Dermatude and LVL Lashes.

Karen is perhaps the best known Permanent Cosmetics Artist and respected trainer in the UK - her work in the beauty industry is generally regarded as the best there is.



Karen was the winner of 'Woman of the Year 2014' in the EveryWoman/NatWest Awards, in recognition of her contribution to the industry, business success and charity work.

We talked to Karen about her achievements and what inspired her to set up her own business.

How did you start out within the **Beauty Industry?**

At the age of 20 I was a qualified hairdresser and ran my own mobile hairdressing service.

Did you have a vision or plan mapped out at that age?

I always knew I would work for myself, from a young age I imagined running my own successful hair and beauty salon and worked hard to make this a reality. In 1993 aged 26 I opened Chaplin's Hair, Nail and Beauty Salon, at the time of opening the salon I had never even heard of permanent cosmetics, the skill I am now known World Wide for. I've just sold the business to one of the girls I employed as a trainee hairdresser over 15 years ago.

Looking back did you ever expect to achieve so much?

When I discovered permanent cosmetics and went to train in the US I knew there and then my career path was going to take a new direction.

I also knew it would only be a matter of time before someone would develop a training programme in the UK and bring in the equipment needed to improve the result and I thought why can't that person be me.

Over the years many journalists have asked me the following question - As a newly trained permanent makeup artist what made you think you were good enough to train others?

I had actually done 6 years as a permanent make-up artist before I opened my training school

Nouveau Beauty Group, without these former years I would never have gained the experience or knowledge I have now. I genuinely am able to empathise with my students as everything they feel as a newly trained artist I too have felt.

At school, I was dyslexic, I still am, I always had to work harder than everyone else to complete my work. Determined not to let dyslexia hold me back I would practice things over and over again, the repetition helped me retain and remember things.

I was also fiercely competitive and wanted to prove dyslexia did not mean I was not clever. I always excelled in creative subjects like art and drama, plus I was very good with figures so got top grades at maths.



When I first completed my permanent cosmetics training, I would spend hours drawing one hair stroke over and over again. I would not move on to drawing a full brow until each stroke was perfect. While initially I followed the technique I learnt on the training course, I soon began experimenting with different combinations of strokes to create the illusion of texture.

I knew I had an innate ability that I wanted to share. It was this belief in myself from the start that made me confident when tattooing clients and my confidence in turn reassured the client they were in safe hands.

Confidence, however, will only take you so far, and you can't build a reputation and training brand on confidence alone. The minute I started developing a training programme I had committed myself to becoming a teacher and good teachers become better teachers by continuing their education.

I also made a promise to myself that I would show my students what to do as opposed to telling them what to do. I believe this style of teaching builds trust; something that has become synonymous with my brand.

However, I do not want people to read this and think my journey from an independent artist to the MD of the UK's largest permanent make-up academy has been an easy one.

There have been LOTS of bumps in the road; I have made numerous mistakes, and some bad decisions along the way and I have not achieved my current success all by myself. I owe a great deal to my partner Dave, my permanent make-up peers, friends, and of course staff.

The big turning point came in 2012 when I was appointed the official consultant and medical tattoo artist for The Katie Piper Foundation. Despite having started my journey into permanent makeup to help a friend restore the eyebrows she lost after treatment for breast cancer, very few people were aware of the remedial benefits.

Suddenly, Katie Piper was telling anyone that would listen I had recreated her eyebrows and given her a more symmetrical lip line after an acid attack left her facial features unrecognisable.

Both Katie and I wanted to make this service available to others who had been burnt, scarred or disfigured as a result of an accident, illness or it saddens me to say an act of violence.

Katie and I began to promote my services and those of my elite team of artists through her charitable organisation and continue to do so today.

Did you ever think you'd be receiving multiple awards for your achievements, in particular the Natwest Everywoman Award which must have been amazing to win?

No I did not, and if it was not for my PR & Events manager and longstanding staff member Lynsey, filling in all the required paperwork I would not have been shortlisted. It has been her belief in my abilities, achievements and our joint persistence in wanting to educate the public that has resulted in thousands of people, myself included, having an emotionally and financially rewarding career. Not to mention all the people that have now personally benefited from cosmetic and medical tattooing treatments.




I will be eternally grateful to the judges that interviewed and selected me as Natwest Everywoman of the year 2015, I proudly display the award in my training centre and for me it signifies every inspirational and financially stable woman that walks through my doors, doing what they enjoy and managing themselves and their destiny.

If you could go back in time and give that 20 year old starting out in business some advice what would it be?

That you can be creative and strategic at the same time, for many years I approached everything like a scattergun. As a naturally creative thinker I change my mind all the time, I used to find unwillingness and inability to change frustrating but as I've grown into a business woman, I now also appreciate and respect there is a need for structure and planning if you want to develop an international brand.



PRO BEAUTY AWARDS PROFILE Mimosa Beauty



Skincare and waxing are the main focus at Mimosa Beauty in Chelmsford, Founder Jennie Lawson has won awards before for her commitment to making every client feel beautiful. A past winner of the 2014 BABTAC Small Salon of the Year, and a finalist in 2015, she is somewhat of an award veteran.

Not bad considering her young age. Still only in her 20s, Jennie has a wealth of experience behind her that has contributed to her success. In fact, it seems the only barrier her age has presented is that she is constantly feeling as though she has to prove herself, which is a motivation, rather than a problem. After studying at the Ray Cochrane Beauty School, she worked at Hoar Cross Hall in Staffordshire, at local salons, and then with Virgin. She learnt different lessons from each workplace, which helped and inspired her to create Mimosa.

Tucked away on a side street, at the end of Broomfield Road, the salon offers a very intimate and restful atmosphere. Jennie books clients four to six months in advance, and has a regular client base of over 400 people. With an ethos of "Everybody deserves a little "me" time," it is easy to see why the salon is so popular.

Knowing that she had to fit in a mystery shopper client was tricky for Jennie, thanks to her busy diary. Somehow she managed to book them in before the judging deadline, but was still unaware as to which client it was. She enjoys the judging process because it allows her to reflect on her journey so far, and think about how she can grow in the future. She says: "I would encourage any salon to apply for the awards, even the application questions make you think about your whole business and how you started."

As well as skincare and waxing treatments, the salon also offers eyelash tints, manicures and pedicures, massage and electrolysis, as well as specialised treatments for pregnant women and men.

Jennie is renowned for performing almost painless waxing treatments, as well as treating numerous chronic skin problems. Her skin expertise means that she has been able to make a difference where even doctors could not prescribe a solution.

The salon uses Priori skincare, a brand that specialises in anti-ageing products, and has a wealth of science behind it. These are medical grade products that are not available for clients to buy on the high street, and these seem to be reason enough for them to return to Mimosa again and again.

Four years after its creation, Jennie feels she is ready for expansion, and is excited for the next challenge. She has recently employed her first staff: a PA and an administrator and is currently looking for a larger place to rent. She is even looking to take her brand international, no doubt inspired by her time working for Virgin.



THE IMPORTANCE OF PATCH TESTS

We perform a number of treatments here at BATG that require a tint test 24 to 48 hours before the actually treatment takes place. It is important to recognise why you must have a test before each treatment. Apart from being a legal requirement on the salon's part, any salon not carrying out tint tests will NOT be covered by insurance if you get a reaction even if you signed to say you took one and did not, the consequences of developing a reaction can be quite horrific.

Many tints contain a chemical called PPD, which is a known irritant and is often the culprit when there are reactions to a tint test. There are other ingredients in tint tests that can also cause a reaction along with instructions of use not being adhered to. This is why it is always best to ensure your treatment, is carried out by trained professionals. All our girls here at the salon have had the highest levels of training.



Reactions from a tint test can range from mild irritation, redness and inflammation to more severe swelling, nausea, vomiting and even in some cases anaphylactic shock.

Carrying out a tint test prior to your treatment will help to ascertain if you could be allergic to anything



the tint contains. The test involves a small amount of tint that will be applied either behind your ear or on the inside of your elbow.

These patch tests MUST be carried out before every single treatment even if you have had that treatment previously, this is because an allergy can develop at any time, even if you have never had a reaction before.

Just because you have had the treatment before does not protect you from having a reaction.

Also if you are having the "same treatment" at another salon you cannot be 100% sure they are actually using the same tint you have had previously elsewhere.





BATG Home Tint Test Postal Service

We recognise and strictly adhere to our policy of clients having a tint test before every single treatment but we also realise that it's often difficult to find the time to visit the salon for a tint test prior to your treatment.

This is why we launched our Home Tint Test Postal Service back in 2014. We are the only salon in the UK to offer this as a service to clients and it has saved many of our clients time and money when booking in for any of the treatments that require a tint test, such as HD Brows & LVL Lashes.

Your details are taken at the time of your booking and before you are due to visit the salon you will receive your tint test along with full instructions direct from us through your letterbox. All absolutely **FREE** and part of the service and experience we provide to all our clients!

New Year Nail Trends

The New Year represents new beginnings. Perhaps this year your resolution should be to ensure your nails are always on trend and fabulous. Whatever your nail design preference, you are sure to find some inspiration here.



Moon Manicure

Closely related to the French manicure, the moon manicure highlights the curve of the moon on the nail, rather than the tip. It is another design that has risen in popularity in the past few years, but for the New Year, the contrast is between shiny and matte polishes, rather than differing colours.

This design looks great in Shellac polish, since the matte finish is easily created through a light buffing, rather than relying on the application of a matte top coat. Choose black, or a darker colour, for the most obvious contrast. Red looks amazing too.





French Manicure


